A joint meeting of the ECC Trustees and Council Members was held on December 6, 2023.

The Trustees Meeting was called to order by Chairman Steve Holloway at 6:16 P.M.

Prayer was led by Rev. Steve Barrett.

Attendees: Todd Montague, Kathy Stock, Pastor Gloria Smith, Steve Barrett, Lisa Herrmann, Kathy Van Etten, John Hasenstab, Patty Roberts, Melanie Herrmann, Del Krietenstein, Marilyn Hall.

Pastor Gloria provided a delicious dinner for the meeting, and it was really enjoyed and appreciated by all in attendance; a brief pause was taken and dinner was self-served.

The Joint meeting was resumed at 6:50 P.M.

The Trustees Meeting minutes for the November 8, 2023 meeting were reviewed, voted upon and accepted into the church records.

Facilities Report given by Steve Holloway: The Church Sign work is ongoing, the Plexiglas and lettering can be done within our proposed budget; Smart locks have been purchased, but another set is needed for the outside bathroom door; the blinds have been purchased and installed in the Fellowship Hall basement; the ceiling tiles in the nursery still need to be replaced; the wings in the Rose Garden area may need to be scheduled for repairs; the exterminator will treat the new trail site found in the Church Office area; the site for the first aid kit will be prepped for mounting to ensure no wall damage; based on recent activity, we will be securing the costume cabinets; the Duke Property owners have been contacted to address the problem issues affecting the ECC Campus.

Tech and Security: The Sanctuary mics were reconfigured to improve the sound for the Christmas Cantata; rekeying will be done in January; Deacons security training is scheduled for mid-January; and the Evacuation Maps are being framed for mounting in the needed sites.

Treasurer's Report given by Kathy Van Etten; the Endowment Fund rebounded upward for the past month. Many of our expenses are now caught up. There are now new bank fees for our Church account as part of Chase's new rules. The Insurance numbers for 2024 have been received, the Workers Compensation premium will increase \$300.00 and the ECC liability coverage premium will increase \$2000.00 for the upcoming year.

The ECC Trustees Meeting was adjourned by Chairman Steve Holloway at 7:36 P.M.

The ECC Council Meeting for December 6, 2023 was called to order by Moderator Lisa Herrmann at 7:40 P.M.

The Deacons Report was given by John Hasenstab; the Sanctuary Christmas decorations and the Emergency Buckets are completed. The Sanctuary has been decorated for Advent. Bibles will be ordered to be given out to requestors. This year for the Christmas Service Offering; the Deacons will be collecting offerings using Christmas Stockings, an announcement will be made at the beginning of the Christmas Services. The Deacons will be meeting on December 10, 2023 after Sunday Services.

Stewardship Report given by John Hasenstab; a total of 23 pledge cards were received for monetary and services pledges.

Pastoral Report given by Pastor Gloria Smith; Google has been contacted for corrections on the ECC postings online. The UCC Conference will be held on April 26th and 27th, 2024 at the Shepherd of the Hills UCC Campus in Phoenix, Arizona.
